Do not use bags made of plastic or compostable bioplastics</p> <p>Biodegradable waste which does not come from households must be disposed of as commercial waste. You can get more information about this by calling the citizen service line 115.</p> <p>*if unavailable: Compost at home</p>	<p>Waste paper, like: Advertisements Baker's bags, with and without windows Books Brochures Cardboard Cartons Catalogues Document folders made from cardboard Egg cartons Envelopes, with and without windows Journals Leaflets Magazines Newspapers Notebooks Packaging made from paper, cardboard, cartons Paper packaging Paper towels, only when damp Paper, loose Posters Wrapping paper, uncoated Writing paper</p> <p>Waste paper can also be disposed of through the waste paper collections.</p> <p>Tip for more space in the bin: Fold up or tear up cartons to safe space.</p> <p>Avoid unnecessary paper waste by placing a "No adverts" sticker on your letterbox.</p>

Some types of refuse are collected at other disposal facilities, like waste glass, waste textile and green waste containers, composting facilities, recycling centres, bulky waste collection and hazardous waste collection points. All recycling centres accept small electrical and electronic devices up to 50 centimetres in length for free. The recycling centres at Nordbeckenstraße 1 and Maybachstraße 10 b accept large appliances for free. Large electrical appliances (ovens, stoves, fridges and freezers, dryers, washing machine) can be collected upon request. Small appliances can also be collected at the same time free of charge.
